Post size categories:

Category 1: 15-26

Category 2: 27-46

A Legionnaire who recruits a new 2024 member starting November 10th will have their name entered into a drawing. VA HEALTH CARE EXPANSION

The VA has announced that all veterans who were exposed to toxins and other hazards while serving in the military – at home or abroad – will be eligible to enroll directly in VA health care beginning March 5, 2024. All veterans who served in the Vietnam War, the Gulf War, Iraq, Afghanistan, the Global War on Terror, or any other combat zone after 9/11 will be eligible to enroll directly in VA health care without first applying for VA benefits. Additionally, veterans who never deployed but were exposed to toxins or hazards while training or on active duty will also be eligible to enroll.

2024 CHILD AND YOUTH VOLUNTEER ASSISTANCE FOR, Pierre - ClubHouse Hotel & Suites THIS SUMMER.

Over the course of the past five years, the American Legion, Department of South Dakota has volunteered their time and resources to assist Operation Homefront with programs to aid young service members and their families in time of need. Our Legionnaires have help to pick up and distribute donate school supplies from various Dollar Tree stores throughout the state in the summertime for distribution in August. Donations of small gifts for children are also picked up by these same volunteers in November from Dollar Tree stores for distribution in December.

For the past three years, some of these Dollar Tree stores have had volunteers from local Family Readiness Support Groups, with affiliation to local National Guard Armories, picking up these donated items. Those stores located in communities with no Amory or Family Readiness Support Group, have seen our Legion volunteers step up to ensure the donations are picked up and distributed accordingly.

This year is no exception. We are looking for volunteers in the Sioux Falls, Brookings, Sisseton, and Pierre areas. If you are interested in becoming a volunteer to pick up these donated items, please contact myself, for more info.

A second program of Operation Homefront this summer is the Back to School Round Up at Ellsworth AFB. This is taking place on July 27th from 0900-1200 at the Dakotas Plaza, on base. Volunteers from the Legion Family and VFW in the Black Hills area will be on site to assist as needed. Organizations can also have information tables set up to advise about programs to assist young Soldiers and Airman. If you are interested in volunteering for this event, contact me prior to the event for base access or if your Post would like to donate school supplies in any significant amount at this event please reach out to me.

If your Post would like to donate funds to aid our young service members through programs of Operation Homefront, please send your donation to the Department HQ. Please make the check out to the "American Legion, Department of South Dakota" and place a note in the Memo area that states "Operation Homefront Donation". Any donated funds will be forwarded to Operation Homefront.

Remember, the events and programs listed above are available to all South Dakota Service members, E1-E6, who are currently active duty or have been discharged within the past 10 years with an Honorable discharge, including the National Guard.
